



# Grambling High Alumni Association

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## Legacy Project

**Background.** The Legacy Project began as a brainchild of the Class of 1991 to mentor the current 4<sup>th</sup> graders at AJB. The Project is now being expanded to include all classes at Grambling Laboratory Schools.

**Purpose.** The Legacy Project shall be the primary Alumni Association program for giving back to the Grambling Laboratory Schools. It shall serve to provide an organized way to provide both financial and physical resources to the Laboratory Schools and their students.

**Scope.** The Legacy Project will pair each class at the Laboratory Schools with a Primary Mentor Class and one or more additional Mentor Classes. The Primary Mentor Class shall be assigned to the Grambling High School class that will graduate on the 30th anniversary of the graduation of the Primary Mentor Class. (i.e. The GHS Class of 1991 will mentor the Class of 2021, currently in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade at Alma J. Brown.) Additional Mentor Classes will be the 10<sup>th</sup> and 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary classes. (GHS Classes of 1971 and 2011 for the Class of 2021). A full listing of mentor classes is in the Appendix to this document.

**Requirements.** All Legacy Project activities must be coordinated with the appropriate teacher(s) and approved by the principal in writing (email is acceptable). Off-Campus or after-school activities must also have permission from a parent or guardian. Mentor Classes will be solely responsible for raising funds used for Legacy Project activities. Full reports of all approved activities shall be provided to the Secretary of the Alumni Association. Reports should include at a minimum: (1) brief description of the activity, (2) copy of the principal's approval, (3) financial report.

**Procedures.** Each class participating in the Legacy Project will appoint a Legacy Project Coordinator to organize the mentoring efforts of the class. The Primary Mentor Class Coordinator shall be responsible for working with Additional Mentor Class Coordinators, school officials and the Alumni Association Officers to ensure the success of the Legacy Project.

**Funding.** Each Mentor Class shall be responsible for funding their Legacy Project activities. The Alumni Association has setup a "Restricted Fund" account Community Trust Bank, separate from the General Fund to receive and disburse fund for this Project. Funds raised by each mentor class will be accounted for separately in this account.
